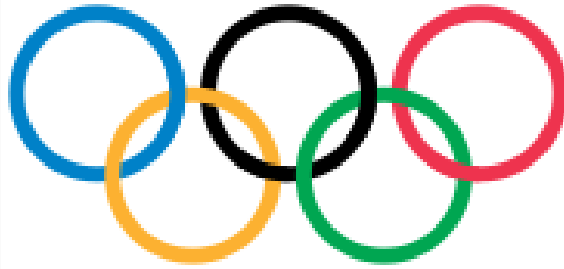

We were thrilled with the terrific turnout from the community, and the support was truly heartwarming.

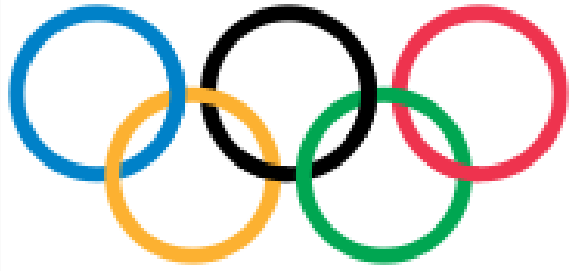
