We utilise the teaching and learning materials of Respectful Relationships Education and the Berry Street Education Model to assist our students in developing social and interpersonal skills, resilience, coping strategies, personal awareness, readiness to learn and body safety.

We also have our School-Wide Positive Behaviour Matrix that explains our expected behaviours. We provide our students with multiple exposures, modelling and social stories to explain these expected behaviours and why a behaviour might be inappropriate and/or unsafe.
