Science

Our Inquiry topic this term is 'Minibeasts'.

Students will investigate and explore
different types of Minibeasts. Students will be
involved in a variety of activities that
explore the different features Minibeasts
have, where different Minibeasts live and
investigate the different life cycles of
Minibeasts. Students will have the
opportunity to participate in our 'Minibeast
Incursion' during the last week of term. Keep

Literacy and Numeracy

During Jolly Phonics, students will continue to build sound, blend and phonic awareness during our daily sessions.

During C.A.F.E. Reading, we will continue to use our Accuracy, Comprehension and Fluency strategies to help decode unfamiliar words and explore Expanding Vocabulary to enhance our reading. Students will continue conferencing one-on-one with their teacher and be involved in daily strategy groups.

During V.O.I.C.E.S, writing students will have the opportunity to write Information Reports on the Minibeast we learn about in class and Procedural Writing about the food they cook in the create kitchen.

During Term 3 Numeracy, students will recap their place value knowledge of addition and subtraction, then move onto skip counting, multiplication and chance. Students will be pre and post tested to ensure they are working towards their own personal goals and will continue to work in 'like ability' groups. These targeted groups will remain on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. Students will continue to be involved in weekly problem solving and fluency sessions and learn different mental and hands on strategies to solve problems.



At the end of Term 2, the Year 1 staff and students enjoyed an excursion to Coal Creek. Students got to see and learn all about what life would have been like over 100 years ago. Students enjoyed walking through the old town and train station and immersing themselves in the one room school, taking part in activities that were very different to their current classrooms.
